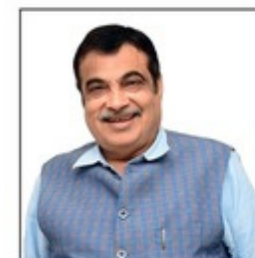

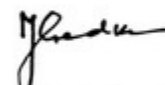
Message
